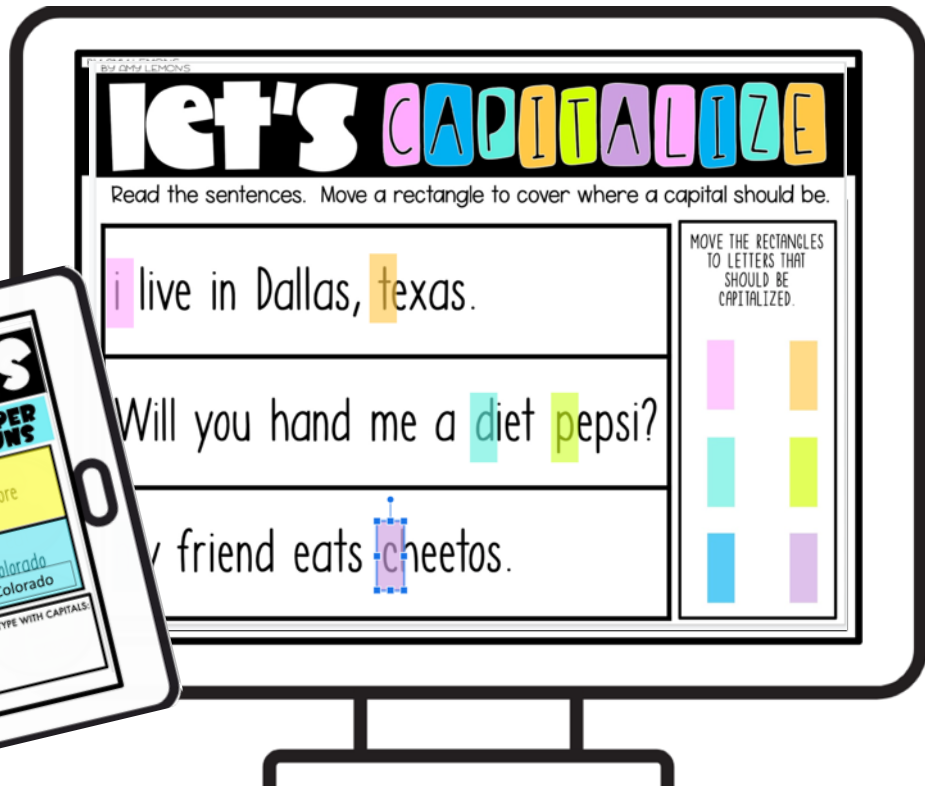
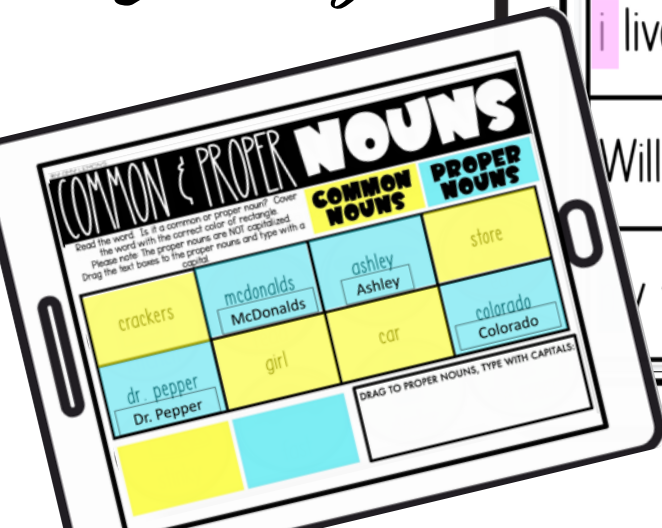

PROPER NOUN
