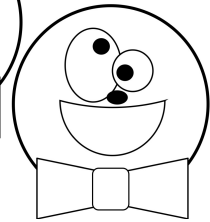
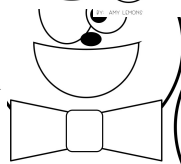
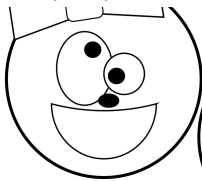
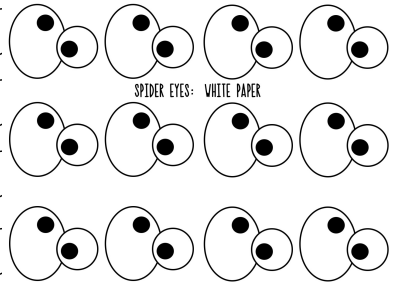
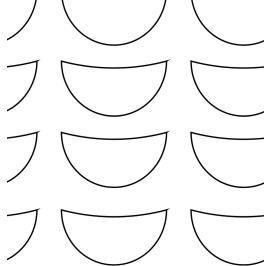
SPIDER BOW: COLORED PAPER

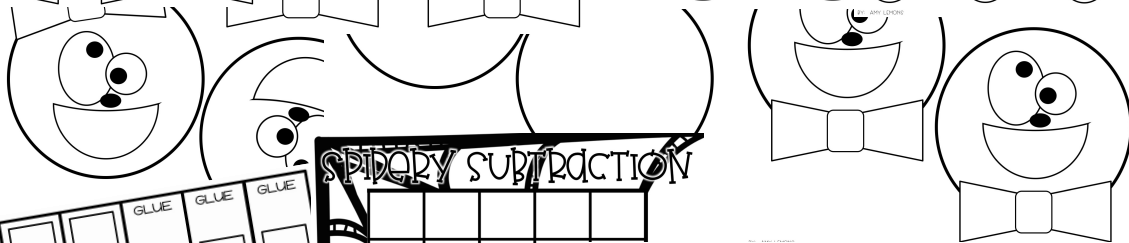
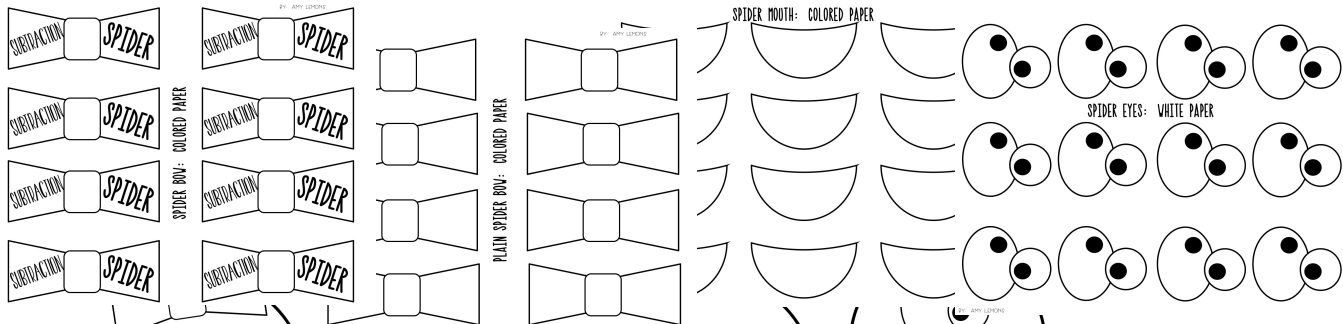
Arachnid
